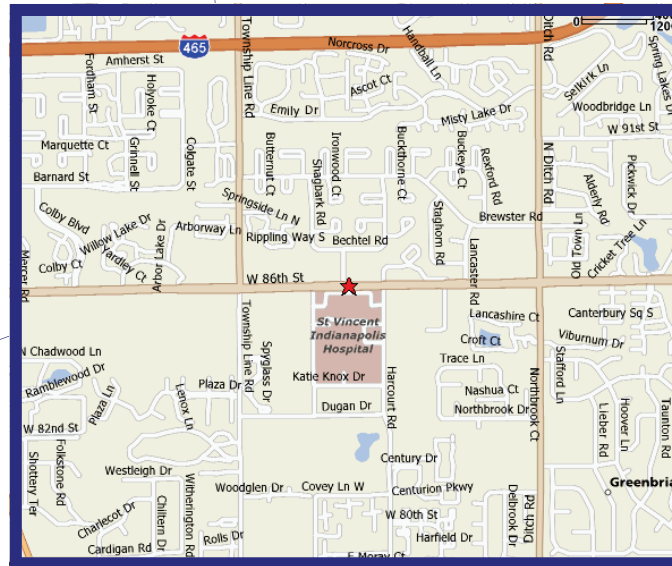


INDIANAPOLIS FACTS
