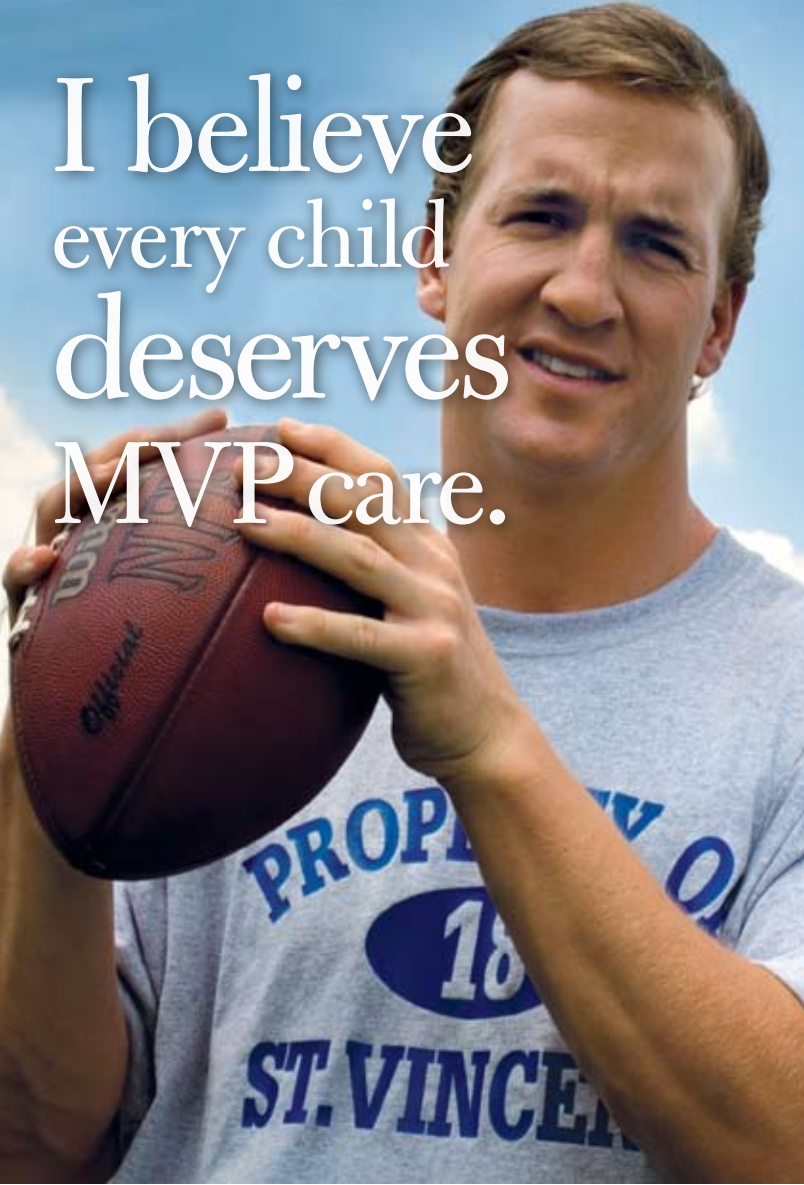

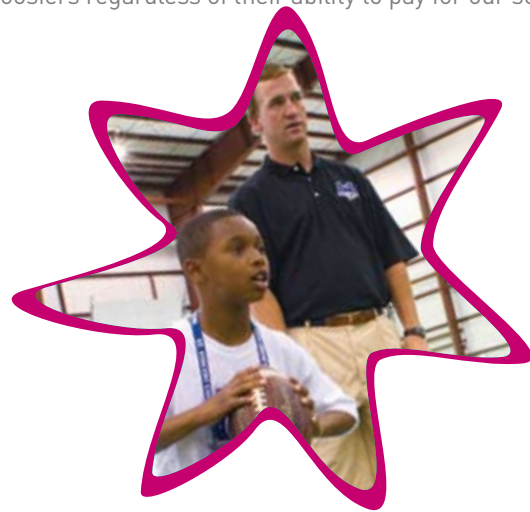


About our extraordinary offerings
