Qualifications and skills required:

- Current education qualifications:
 - Senior enrolled in an ACEND accredited dietetic program
 - DPD Dietetic Intern
 - Post-collegiate graduate in field of nutrition, dietetics, or related field (no current RDs)
- Strong interest and passion for sports nutrition
- Highly motivated leader with strong organization and communication skills
- Ability to work normal business hours with occasional weekend hours (expect 40-45hrs/week)

- Session 2: Jan 25 – Feb 24, 2017 (2 interns accepted)

Application Process:

- October 14th: Application Due
 - Consists of the following items being emailed to anna.turner@stvincent.org:
 - **Cover letter** (indicate preference in Session 1 or 2)
 - **Resume**
 - **List of 3 professional reference contacts (letters not necessary)**
- October 19th: Applicants informed if selected for an interview
- October 22-27th: Interviews will take place for qualified candidates in person, via skype/facetime, or phone (if previous two are not an option).
- October 31th : Applicants are informed if selected for internship (4 total)
